

# **CONTROL BUTTONS / LED**






VEO monitor incorporates an OSD menu that is managed via the monitor's push buttons. The icons displayed are managed with the corresponding buttons located on the monitor.

The white line at the bottom of the icon indicates the function that is currently in effect.

Select with  $\rightarrow$  /  $\checkmark$  the desired icon and confirm with  $\checkmark$  .

# **USER MENU**

1 Monitor volume settings. Upon a call or doorbell activation.

## 2 Do Not Disturb function:

: The call is not heard.

: The call is heard, (by default normal operation is selected).

Display images: To display the varios photos taken with the date, time and the photo number. 3

When a call is made from the outdoor panel, a photo is automatically taken 5 seconds later and stored in the memory. The image capture function must be pre-selected, see screen «USER PARAMETER SETTINGS», (option 3)



: To select/view the photos stored.

: To clear images.

: To cancel and go to the previous screen.

F2 Function (extra function, check with your installer).

# User parameter settings



Within the USER MENU, selecting the option «USER PARAMETER SETTINGS» will acces a new screen corresponding to the various configuration parameters.

# Melody selection:

: Panel melody selection: It can be changed the melody that you hear on the monitor when a call is made from outdoors.

: Selection of the melody for the doorbell: The melody that will ring upon doorbell activation, if it has been connected to monitor, can be changed.

: Concierge melody selection: It can be changed the melody that you hear on the monitor when the concierge calls that monitor.








#### **AUDIO SETTINGS**
